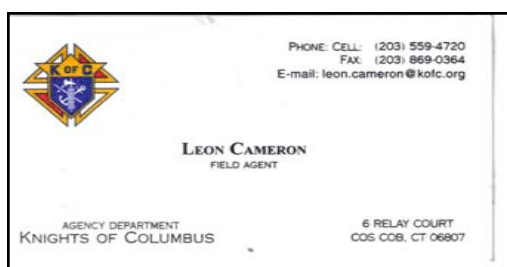
URGENTLY NEEDED

Athletics in Two Pauline Epistles

Brother Knights,

As sports fans, take note of how the Apostle Paul uses examples from athletics as a means of teaching spiritual principles and truths of the faith:

“You know that while all the runners in the stadium take part in the race, the award goes to one man. In that case, run so as to win! Athletes deny themselves all sorts of things. They do this to win a crown of leaves that withers, but we a crown that is imperishable” (1 Cor 9:24-25).

“I do not run like a man who loses sight of the finish line. I do not fight as if I were shadowboxing. What I do is discipline my own body and master it, for fear that after having preached to others I myself should be rejected” (1 Cor 9:26-27).

“...if one takes part in an athletic contest, he cannot receive the winner's crown unless he has kept the rules” (2 Tm 2:5).

“I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith*. From now on a merited crown** awaits me; on that Day the Lord, just judge that he is, will award it to me—and not only to me, but to all who have looked for his appearing with eager longing” (2 Tm 4:7-8).
