Chaplain's Corner

The Most Important Kind of Security

Brother Knights,

We have Social Security and various other kinds of security, but above all we must have SOUL SECURITY.

So, in order to have this most important kind of security, do the following:

1) Always keep in the state of sanctifying grace, a sharing in the life of God Himself, free from mortal sin. Your state of sanctifying grace is, in reality, your "passport" to heaven—to eternal happiness with God. 2) Being in this state, make your Morning Offering, offering up to God out of love for Him all your prayers, works, and sufferings of the day. This will supernaturalize all these good, even ordinary actions and earn for you supernatural merit—an increase of sanctifying grace together with a claim to a corresponding measure of glory and happiness in heaven. 3) Consistently: obey the commandments of God and Church; perform the spiritual and corporal works of mercy; fulfill the obligations of your vocation in life. 4) Attend and participate in the Holy Mass/Divine Liturgy on the Lord's Day, on holy days of obligation, and on other days whenever possible. 5) Receive the sacraments of Penance/Reconciliation and Holy Eucharist worthily, fervently, frequently. 6) Pray the Rosary daily. 7) Avoid the near occasions of sin; take an immediate and effective stand against temptation. 8) Make arrangements *now* to have Holy Masses/Divine Liturgies offered for the repose of your soul after you have departed from this life. Your pastor or chaplain can help you with this. 9) Pray daily for the grace of final perseverance.
