Chaplain's Corner

The Ultimate End or Goal

Brother Knights,

The ultimate end or goal for us human beings is that which will bring us complete, perfect happiness. Now obviously this cannot be attained by the possession of any or all finite or created goods. Sacred Scripture, history, and personal experience certainly teach us that. For neither riches nor power nor honors nor health nor beauty nor sensible pleasure nor any other worldly good can bring us complete, perfect happiness. Evidently, then, our ultimate end or goal lies well beyond the possession of the finite or created goods of this life and world. It lies *precisely* in the attainment of the Infinite and Uncreated Good—God—complete, perfect happiness with God in heaven for all eternity.

That God is our ultimate end or goal is evident also from the very nature of the faculties of our immortal soul—the intellect and the will. Our intellect constantly strives for more and more truth. No degree or kind of finite truth can completely satisfy the intellect. Only the attainment of the Infinite Truth can completely satisfy it. But the Infinite Truth is God. Likewise, our will constantly chooses more and more good. No amount or kind of created good can completely satisfy the will. Only the attainment of the Uncreated Good can completely satisfy it. But the Uncreated Good is God. Thus, God is indeed the ultimate end or goal of these noble faculties of our immortal soul.

Finally, we must always remember that we were created by God, in the image and likeness of God, and for God. Centuries ago, the great St. Augustine, in his autobiography entitled *Confessions*, expressed all this in words that have become classic: “Thou hast made us for Thee, O God, and our heart is restless until it rests in Thee.”
