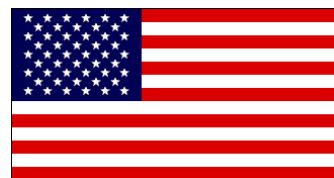

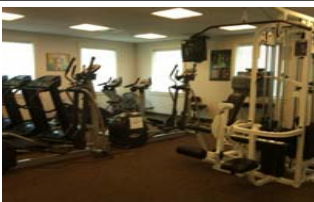

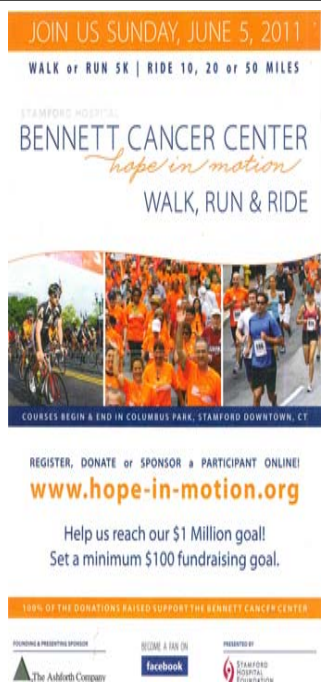
Letters will be mailed to all members who are eligible. If you are one of the members who receive a letter, please complete the response form at the bottom, and mail it to the Council no later than June 6.
