**Dear Brother Knights:** During these Easter weeks we should wish one another a deep and meaningful appreciation of what Easter has brought to humanity since the day Christ rose from the tomb outside Jerusalem.. Not only should we seek an understanding of how Easter changed things, but also an insight and appreciation of how we as Catholics and particularly as Knights of Columbus are actually part of that change and transformation that began so long ago, and is still taking place.
