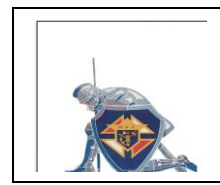

"Therefore, let us celebrate the feast, not with the old yeast, the yeast of malice and wickedness but with the unleaven bread of sincerity and truth."

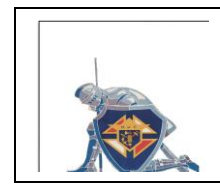
GRAND KNIGHT'S MESSAGE

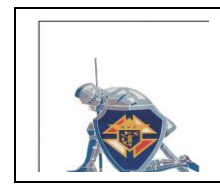


PRIMETIME CATERING

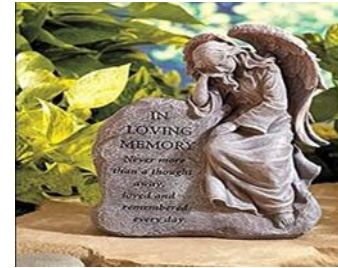
