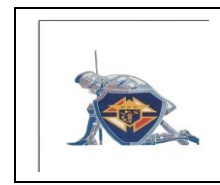

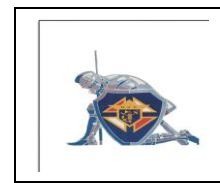
We have so many activities and we as a council do so many great things that are never recognized or mentioned to the public.

PRIMETIME CATERING

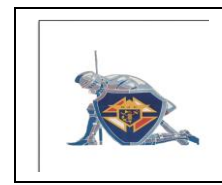
